

ALLOPATHIC MEDICAL SCHOOL ADMISSION DATA 2009, 2008, AND 2007 ENTRANCE

The schools listed below are the AMCAS participating schools which have accepted at least one UCSD graduate in the last three years. UC schools are listed first, then private schools in descending order by the most recent year's average admittant's GPA, then non-California public schools in the same order. For 2008 and 2009, the number of UCSD students who were accepted to each school is preceded by the total number of UCSD students who applied to that same school. The MCAT and overall GPA listed is the school's median for all admitted students as published in the *Medical School Admissions Requirements* book for the respective year.

These charts are provided to help applicants determine their competitiveness at the U.S. allopathic medical schools. However, admission decisions are not based solely on MCAT and GPA. To help determine where to apply, please see an advisor.
